



Pilgrim's Progress Revisited

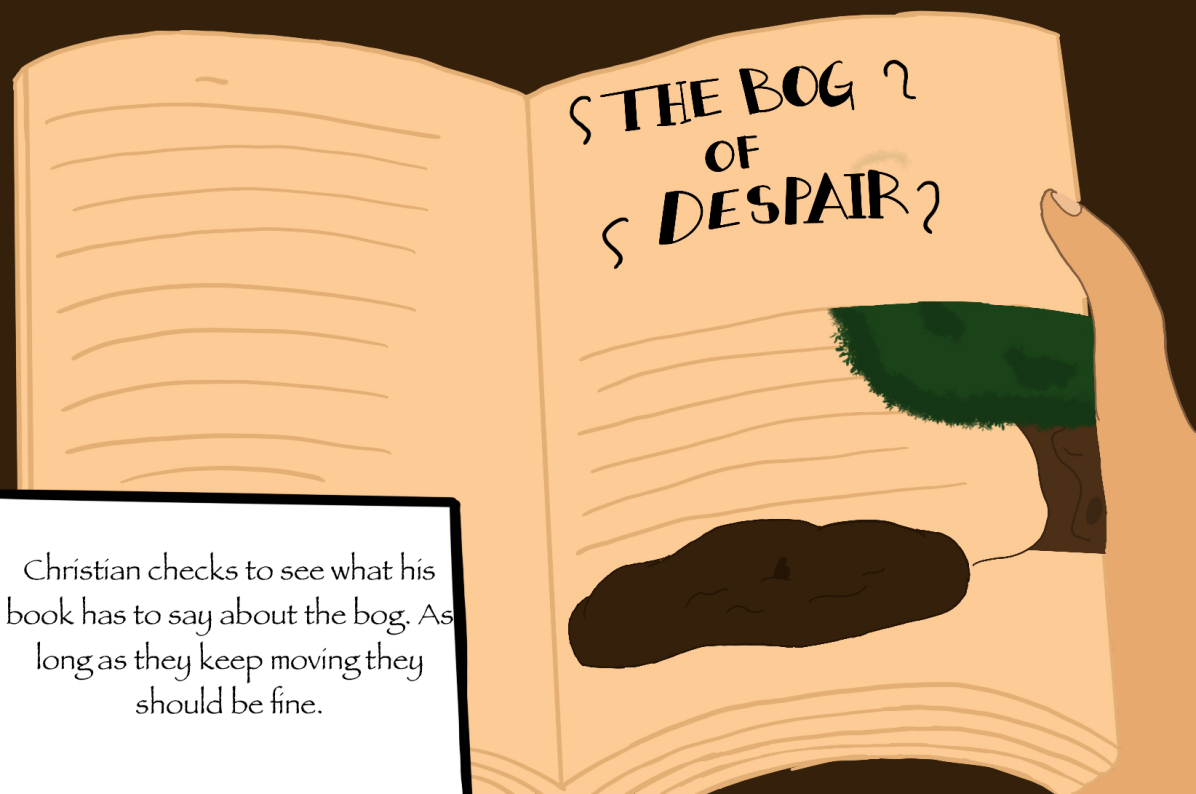


So Christian and Pliant start to making their way through the bog, and at first everything was going smoothly.

Ok, I'm going, I'm going



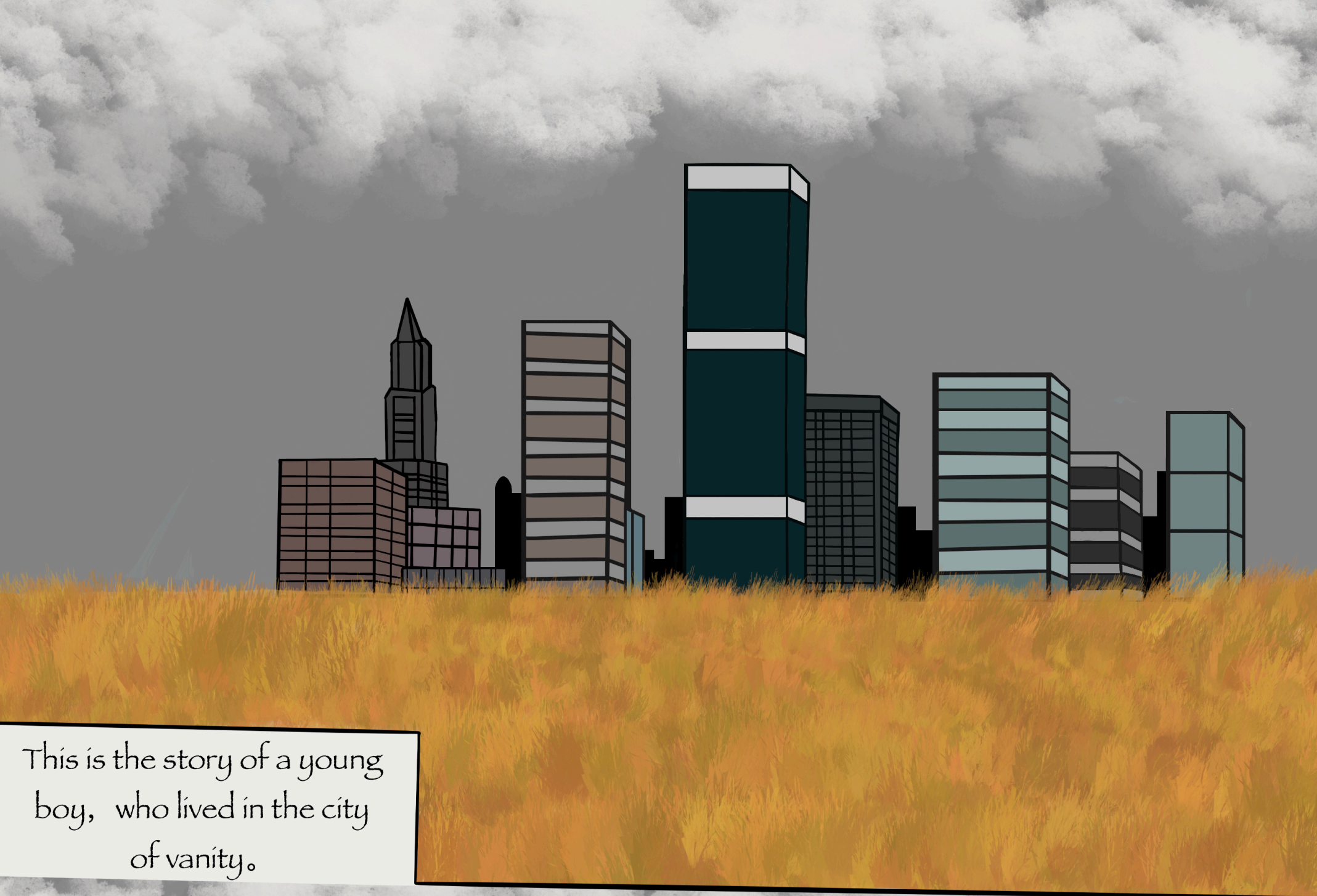

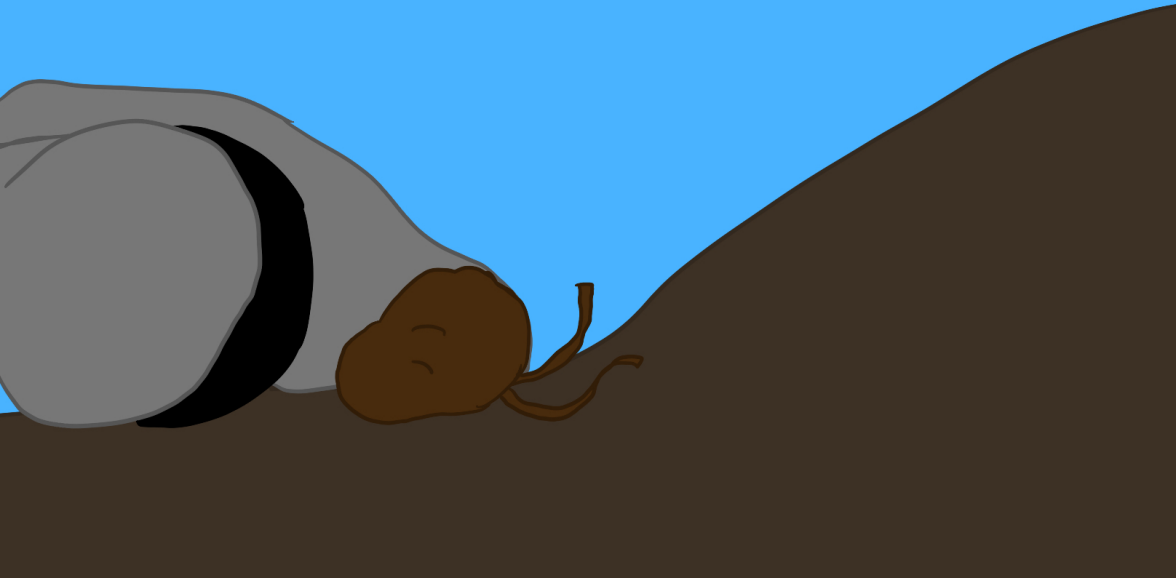
Mr. Evangelist appears again, he

Once beneath the cross, his burden immediately falls off and a new Christian is formed

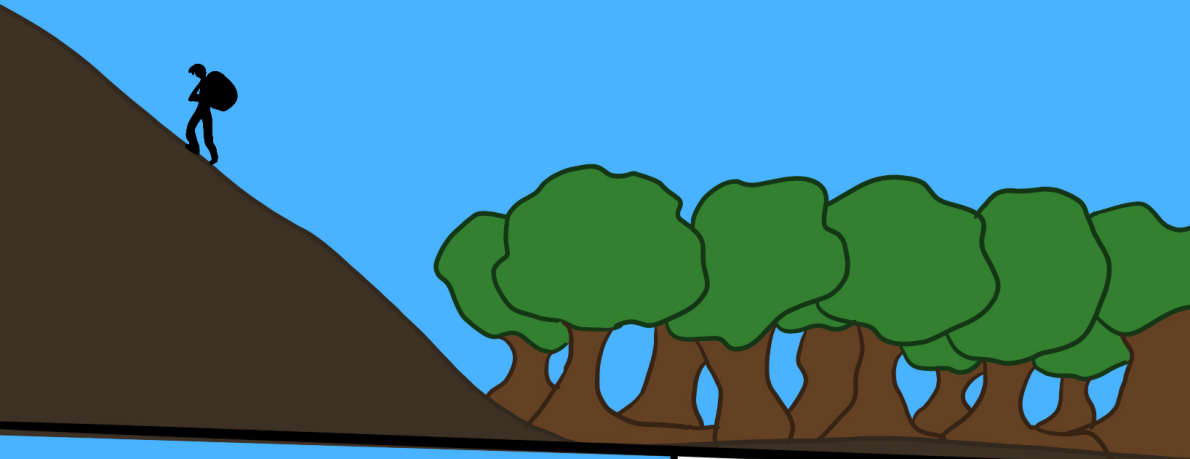


His burden rolls down the hill, to a tomb that is open down below.

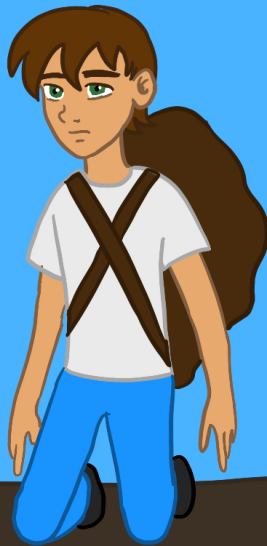
It swallows up the burden and seals shut.

the top.

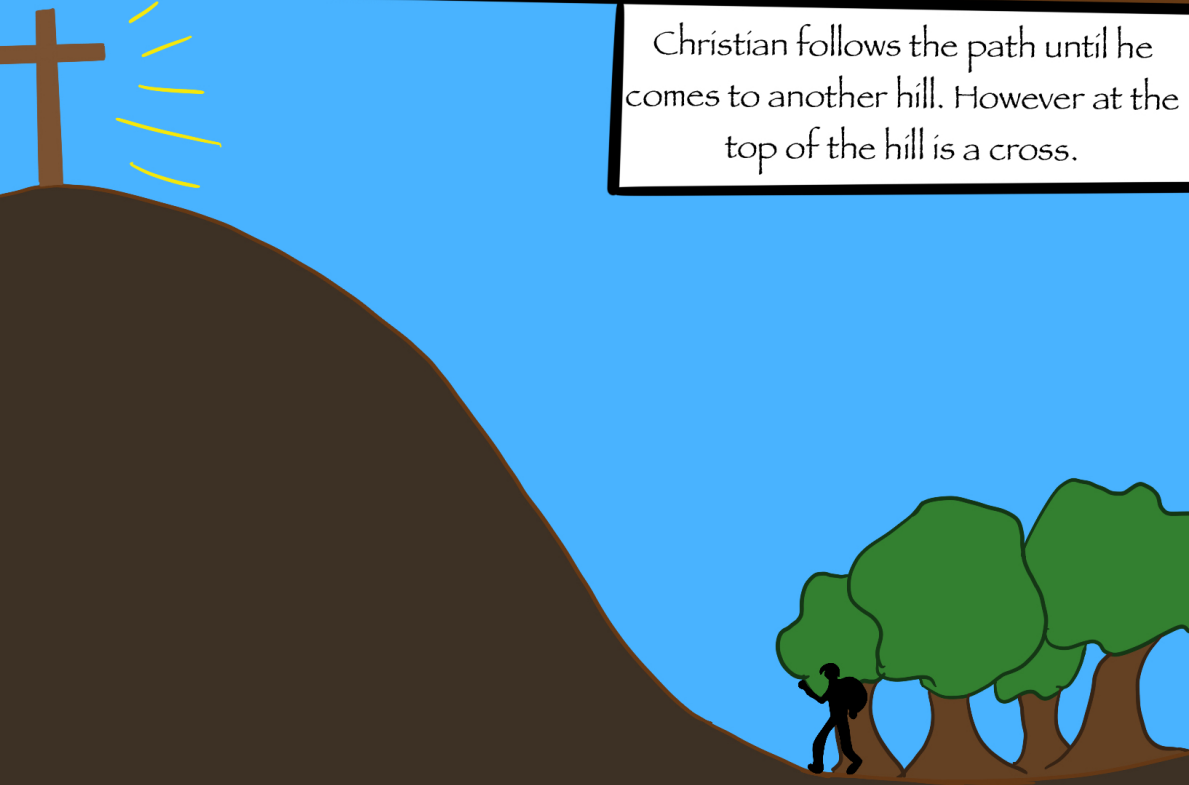


He falls at his knees at the foot

celestial city.



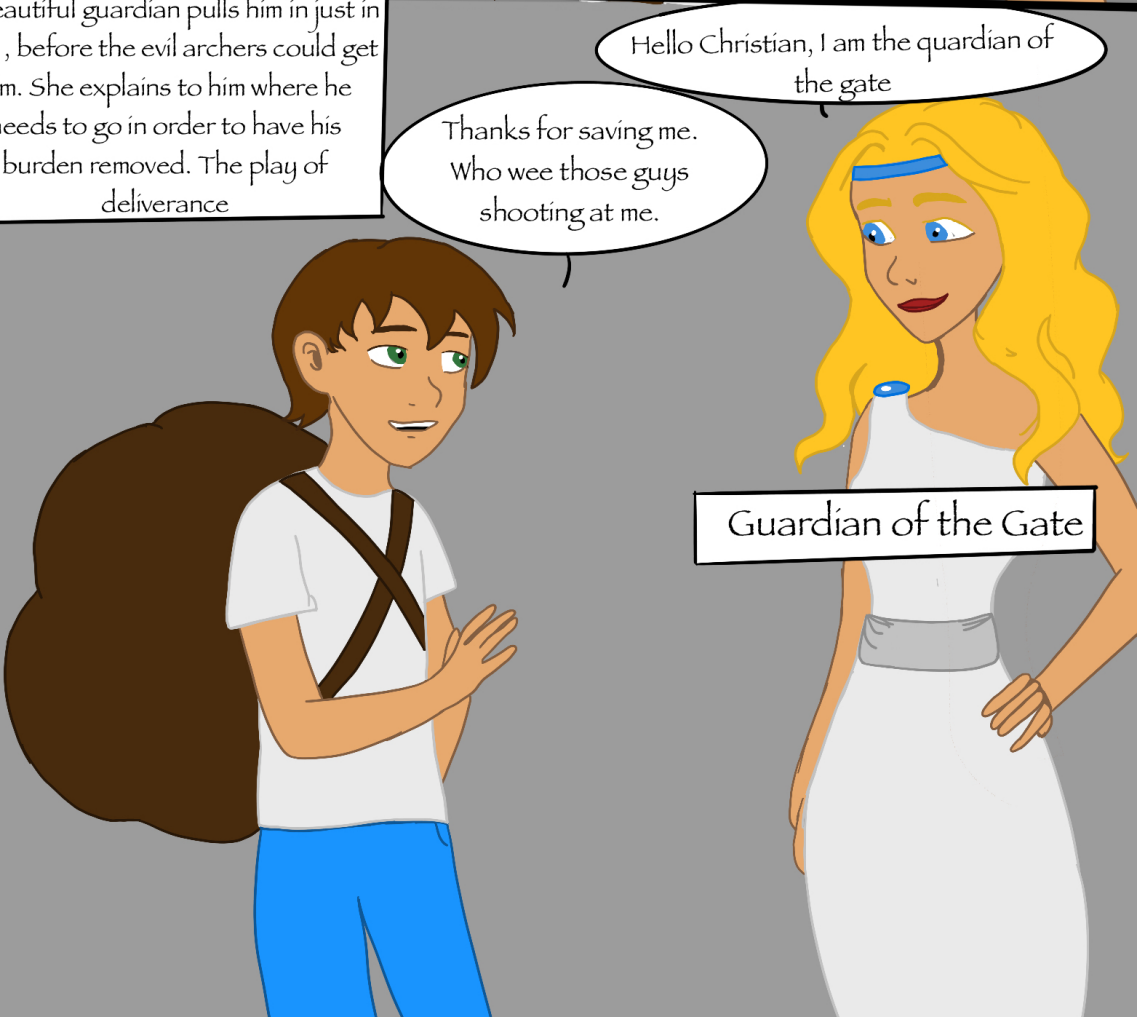
Your next stop is

I will! Thank you!





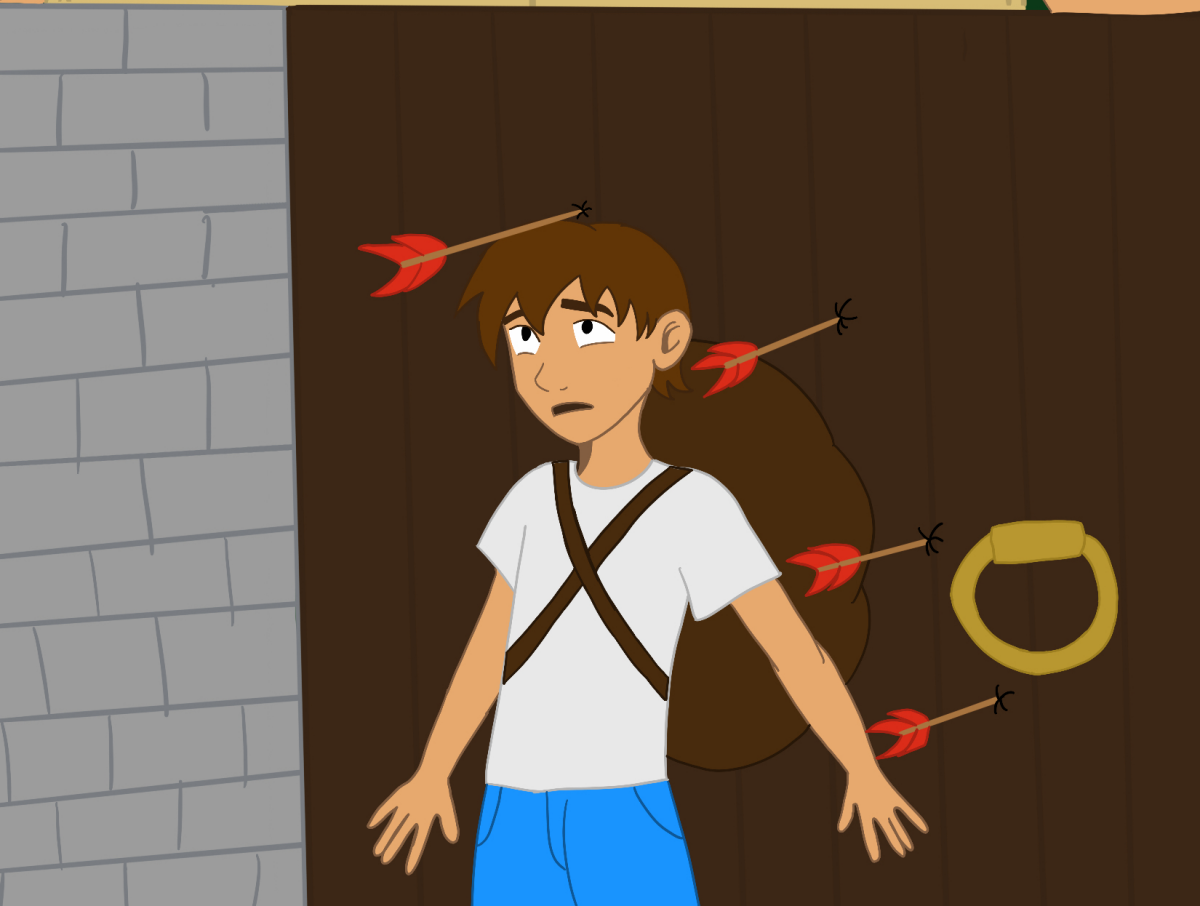
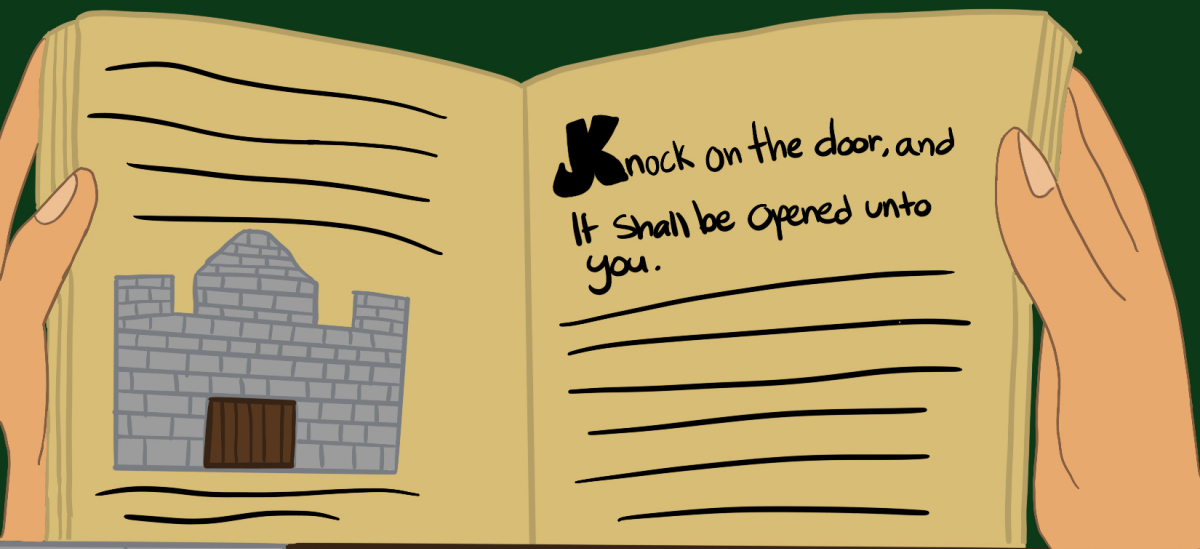
A beautiful guardian pulls him in just in time , before the evil archers could get him. She explains to him where he needs to go in order to have his burden removed. The play of deliverance



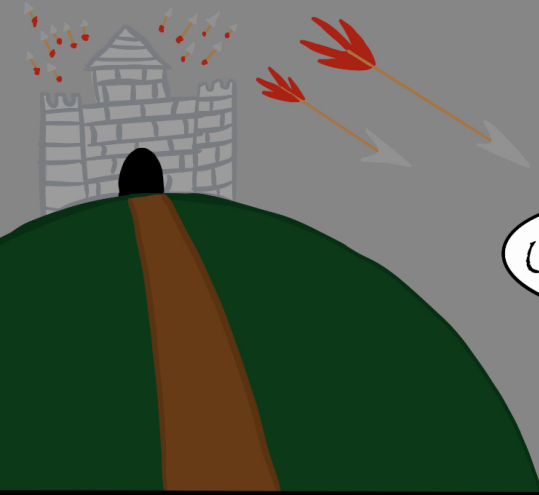

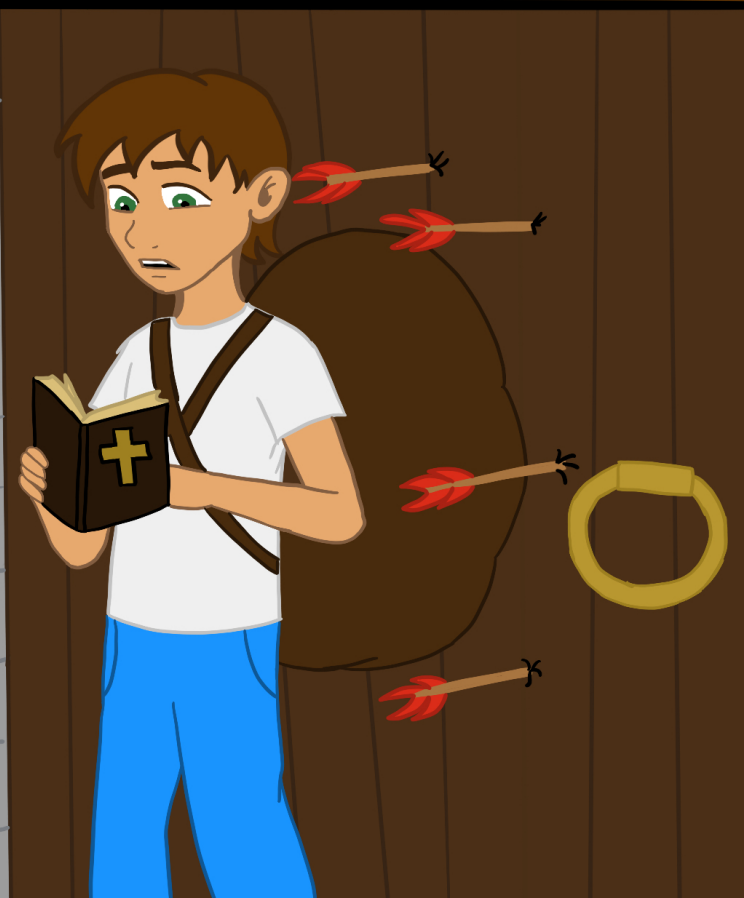
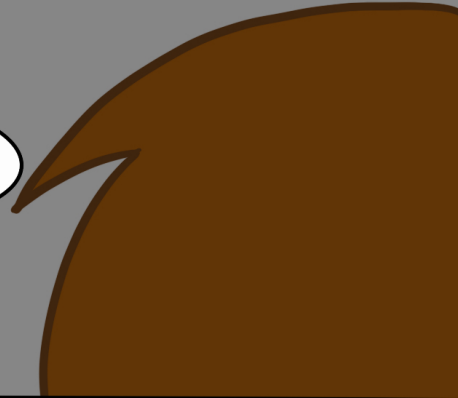
Guardian of the Gate

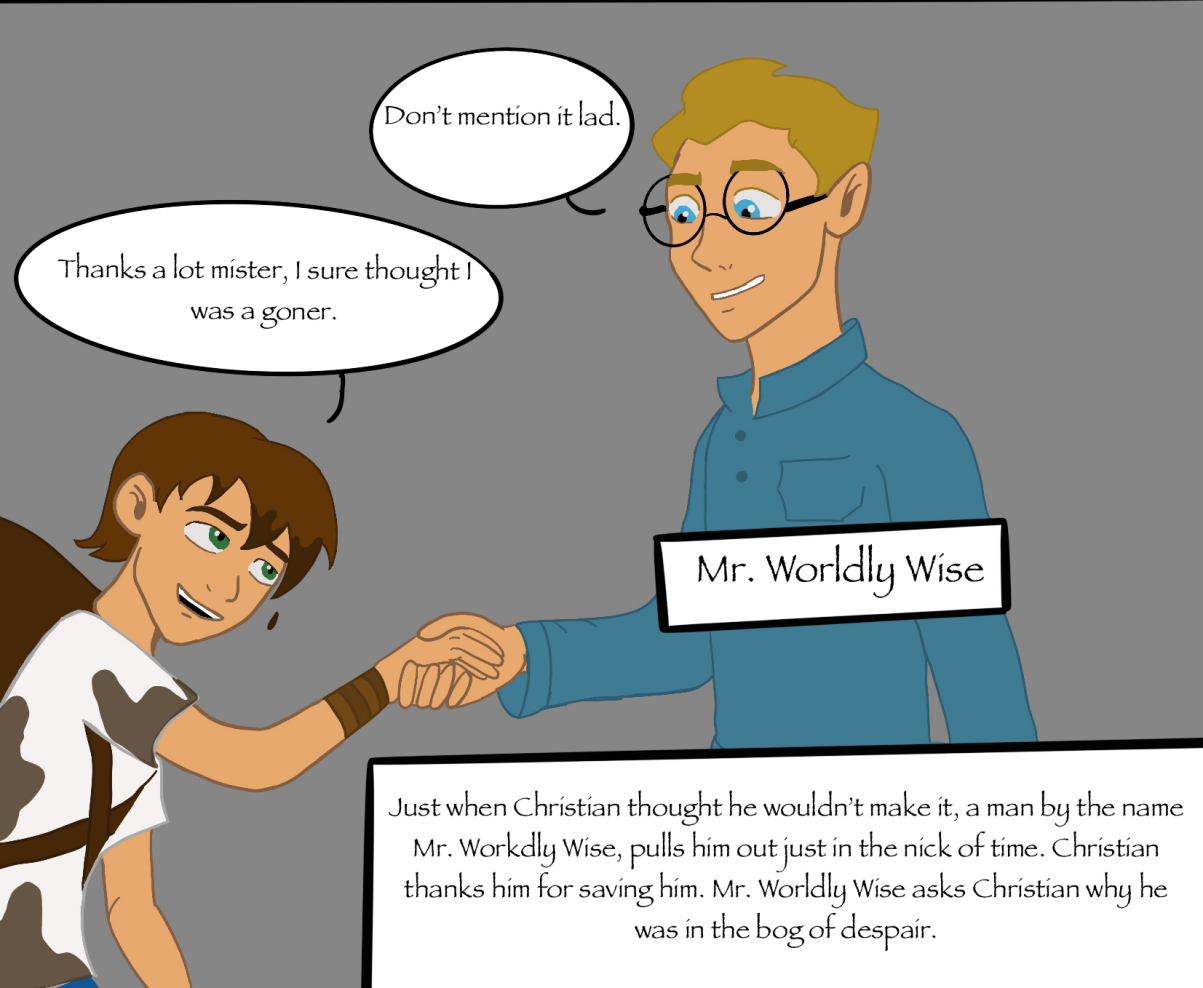
