

Sermon on the Mount Project

- 1) Choose 3 Pericopes to cover (see back of sheet)
- 2) Rewrite the lessons in children friendly language (preferable poetry)
- 3) Illustrate the stories in child friendly format (colorful/clean/maybe whimsical)
- 4) Bind together in a book form
- 5) Hand in!

You can work in (up to) groups of three. The length is “complete”. In other words, there isn’t a specified length but you need to be complete in the telling of the pericope. Also, keep in mind that most CSB (Children Story Books) keep pages simple in the amount of text—don’t overload a page!

Don’t forget to check the various rubrics that are applicable

NOTE: extra credit ideas could include media that accompanies (audio sing along or video shorts with puppets) the text. Also consider multiple language translations.
